Our guide will show us the city's most iconic landmarks and tell fascinating stories of their past and present as we navigate through the bustling streets. The tour will come to an end at the centrally located Hotel 4 Barcelona where we'll settle in and freshen up for dinner.

#### DAY 3 WEDNESDAY, APRIL 24

(Breakfast) Enjoy breakfast before a **full day of exploring Barcelona**. This capital city of Catalonia has long been a hub of creativity, innovation, and artistic expression. From the iconic works of Antoni Gaudí to the captivating performances of flamenco dancers, it truly embodies the essence of Catalan culture. Our tour will introduce us to the medieval streets of the Gothic Quarter; the famous pedestrian-only boulevard, Las Ramblas; and Passeig de Gracia, regarded as the most expensive street in the country. Included is a stop at the aweinspiring La Sagrada Familia. With an extensive network of extraordinary pillars soaring toward the ceiling to create a massive image of a tree, windows that give the effect of filtered sunlight through forest branches, swelling spires, and minimal use of straight lines, there is an undeniable fascination with this masterpiece! Then we'll have the opportunity to stroll through Park Güell to enjoy panoramic views of the city and admire Gaudí's signature colorful mosaics. After an amazing day of sightseeing, dinner is on your own this evening.

# ZARAGOZA, SPAIN

(Breakfast, Dinner) Our adventure today will take us to Zaragoza, where remnants of the city's rule by the Romans, Goths, Moors, Aragonese, and Catholic Monarchs over the course of its more than 2,000-year history are still visible today. The city is most known for the baroque Basilica de Nuestra Señora del Pilar. The cathedral has many intriguing stories and is filled with art and ornate sculptures. We'll visit the imposing basilica as we tour the city before settling into the Hotel Eurostars Zaragoza and gathering for a delicious dinner together.

Located next to the stunning Plaza de Oriente is the Palacio Real, the largest royal palace in Europe. Boasting 1,450,000 square feet and 3,418 rooms, it is almost double the size of Buckingham Palace! We will walk the halls of this grand palace and then explore the Prado Museum, one of the world's most iconic and important art museums. The vast collection of masterpieces by Velazquez, Goya, El Greco, Rembrandt, and others is astonishing! We'll end our day with dinner on our own.

We bid farewell to Madrid after breakfast this morning and continue our journey to the hidden gem of Jaén, a city in southern Spain known for its olive oil production and fortresses. The city has an ancient and fascinating history with winding streets and medieval castles. Our tour of the city will take us to Plaza Santa Maria to visit the splendid Renaissance-style Jaén Cathedral, home to a copy of the Holy Veil said to have been used by Saint Veronica to wash Christ's face. Many fascinating stories and magnificent views of the city await as we stroll through the halls of the cathedral! Relax and enjoy this afternoon's drive through Spain's Andalusia region to Granada in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada mountains where our accommodations at Gran Hotel Luna de Granada for the next two nights await. Grab dinner and one of the countless restaurants located within easy walking distance of the hotel.

#### DAY 8 **MONDAY, APRIL 29**

**GRANADA**, SPAIN

## An exciting day of touring awaits us today in Granada, a city known for its delicious tapas and architectural wonders such as the Alhambra. Built as a "paradise on Earth" by thirteenth-century caliphs, the palace ranks among the world's finest examples of Moorish architecture. Our visit here (subject to availability) will introduce us to the incredible history and architecture of this monumental complex, including the Nasrid palaces where the royal family lived. We'll admire the intricately carved stonework and the complex geometric designs of the numerous courtyards, labyrinthine hallways, and elegant gardens before heading across the valley to walk through the serene Generalife. These beautiful Arab gardens are a magnificent combination of Moorish architecture, water features, flower beds, and large topiaries built as a private retreat for rulers and the elite. The afternoon is at your leisure to explore Granada's Old Town. A very special evening awaits us in the caves of Sacromonte, Granada's old Gypsy neighborhood. Families from all over Spain would gather in these large caves to dance and sing. We'll be immersed in this colorful tradition with **dinner and an outstanding flamenco show**.

#### DAY 9 **TUESDAY, APRIL 30**

Our day will begin with breakfast before we depart for the historic city of **Cordoba**. Founded by the Romans and later conquered by the Visigoths, Muslims, and Christians, this city is one of the most cultured and refined cities of medieval Europe. Here we will visit La Mezquita de Cordoba, a masterpiece of architecture and art that reveals its nearly 1,200-year history as an early Christian church, a Moorish mosque, and a Roman Catholic cathedral. Its candy-striped walls and decorative details are astonishing! We'll also marvel at the maze of cobbled streets and hidden gems as we stroll through the **old Jewish Quarter** before heading to the beautiful city of Seville for dinner and a two-night stay at Hotel Silken Al-Andalus Palace.

We'll end our exploration with a stroll through the romantic Barrio Santa Cruz, a colorful old quarter of Seville with winding cobbled streets, whitewashed houses, and eye-catching floral accents.
